What is Mountain of Manhood?

Mountain of Manhood is a Lab tradition. This overnight adventure offers bonding time with the guys of the Lab, the youth staff, as well as learning about life in the outdoors. Through events such as 'Mountain of Manhood,' teenagers are influenced through teaching, training, memories, and building strong relationships with each other. You will NOT want to miss it!!

Who is Mountain of Manhood for?

- Senior High male youth: *Those going to grade 10 in September, to those who have just completed grade 12.*
- Friends are welcome, as well as those who do not attend Living Waters. We do however, have to be able to trust them in the sense that they are able to cooperate with fellow youth and youth staff.

What are we doing?

- We will be traveling to Harrison Lake where we will chill out in the sun, sunning, hiking, exploring the wilderness.
- We have a boat that will take us to an island where we will camp out in tents.
- We will have teaching relevant to young men, focusing specifically on wisdom.

What are the dates & times?

- Friday, August 27th to Saturday, August 28th
 - Drop off @ Living Waters Church: Friday @ 8:00am
 - Pick up @ Living Waters Church: Saturday @ 7:00pm

What is the cost?

- Early registration on or before Sunday, August 8th is \$45
 - Regular registration from August 9-15th is \$50
 - Late registration from August 16-26th is \$55
- This cost covers transportation, parking, boat costs, and the 5 meals.*

Sibling Discount: Male siblings who register have a discount of 10% each

Note:

- Register ASAP. **There is limited space.** Those registering late will only be able to come if there is space available.
- Registration is 50% refundable unless the trip is cancelled due to weather.
- Permission slip and payment **must** be handed in at the same time, only then will you be officially registered!

What do I need to bring?

Changes of clothes, Towel, Bug spray, Swim stuff, Walking/hiking shoes, Sleeping bag, pillow, Flashlight, Toiletries, Toilet paper, Water, Sunscreen, Bible, Small foamy, Garbage bag.

A snack to share (chips/candy/cookies if born on even day. Cans of pop/water/juice if born on odd day)

Life jacket (mark down on p-slip if you have one to bring)

Camping supplies (tent, cooler, lantern, etc. If you have camping supplies please let us know so we can gather enough)

Safety

- Because of *nut allergies*, it is very important that no nuts or items containing nuts are brought on this trip.
- Also for safety do not bring lighters, matches, weapons, large knives, or anything else that could cause damage or harm.
- Drugs or Alcohol **will not** be permitted!

This trip is going to be awesome! We are looking forward to this adventure in the wild. This is a great way to finish off the summer months as we prepare to head back to school (*oops...sorry I brought it up*). Feel free to invite your friends along with us.
